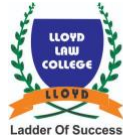

Guidelines/instructions for preparing the Practical course File:

- **First page should be taken from the attachments.**

- Use **plain A4 size paper**. Write on **one side of the paper**. Leave back side of each paper blank.
- Project file shall be **"MANUSCRIPT – HAND WRITTEN"** **single hand written only**. Handwriting should be **neat and legible**.
- **Scrutiny of Practical File** will be done **on the day of Practical Examination** first by our College Faculty and second by the External Examiner from the CCS University, Meerut.
- **MANDATORY PRESENCE** :: Absence in any of the above Practical Course Work Exercise Examination will disentitle the student any marks, attendance, supplementary and fail thereof in all other theory and practical papers as per Examination Rules of the C.C.S. University, Meerut.
- **PLAGIARISM** :: There should not be copying of the file, if found, both the files shall be rejected and marked 'ZERO'. The college shall not be responsible for the wrong doing of the student.
- **UNIFORM** :: Advocate Uniform is mandatory to appear for the 'Practical Paper' Viva-Voce exercise.

PROJECT No :: 01

H K and three others, namely, N, S and A are facing trial for the murder of Z at about 9.00 a.m. on November 03, 2024, in a public place in M Nagar leather market. After the occurrence H K had absconded and he surrendered in court on December 22, 2024.

Now H K is in jail.

Using above premise, draft one bail application for **H. K.**

PROJECT NO :: 02

A is caught red handed stealing a watch from a shop. The shopkeeper caught A and handed him over to police. Police arrested A, and a criminal case was registered against A. After trial, court of magistrate convicted A vide judgment dated 25.01.2021.

Using above premise, draft an appeal for A against above judgment as per new Criminal Law.

PROJECT No :: 03

Draft one civil appeal against original money decree passed by Senor Civil Judge by using rules and all the parameters given in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

PROJECT No :: 04

Mr. X has graduated from Meerut University in the year 1999. He secured a copy of his degree and mark sheets from the said University. Unfortunately, while travelling in a DTC Bus the said documents were way laid and lost. Mr. X has already applied for duplicate copies of the mark sheet and the degree from the said University. The Controller of Examinations had advised Mr. X to file an F.I.R. as regards being said documents and submit a copy of the complaint to the office of the University. The processing of the duplicate certificate is going to take about 3 months. In the meantime, Mr. X has been able to secure an employment with the Govt. Of Delhi. The personale Depp. is insisting that the originals or the duplicate of the academics should be submitted. However, in case, these are unavailable, then an affidavit should be submitted stating the facts of the documents being lost. Draft an appropriate affidavit to the said effect.

PROJECT No :: 05

Collect one plaint from any Civil Suit (from the office of Law Firm/ Advocate where you are engaged in internship or from any other source) and label it on the basis of:

1. Orders, Rules and Appendix and other provisions of C.P.C., 1908 that govern the law of pleadings.
2. Identify and label any three material facts in the plaint.

PROJECT No :: 06

Mr. X is 80 years old. He is an entrepreneur. He is residing in Bangalore. Mr. X has a sugar factory in Muzzaffarnagar in Uttar Pradesh. Owing to his age and various ailments as also his busy schedule, its not possible for him to look after the day to day functioning and management of the industry at Muzzaffarnagar. Mr. M is his trusted friend. Mr. X wants



that Mr. M should manage and administer his sugar factory on his behalf. Resultantly, Mr. X contacts you for drafting an effective Power of Attorney so that in his absence the factory can be seamlessly carried on by Mr. M.

Draft a General Power of Attorney so that Mr. M can administer and manage the said factory without any problems and bureaucratic hiccups.

PROJECT No :: 07

Mr. X is the owner of agricultural land situated in Baramati, Maharashtra. He has a daughter aged 40 years who is differently abled. The daughter is in bad financial condition. Mr. X out of love and affection for his daughter, Mr. X wants to gift the said agricultural land to her.

Draft a gift deed in favor of the daughter.

PROJECT No :: 08

Mr. X is 75 years old. He has two sons and a daughter. The daughter is happily married in Dubai. The two sons of Mr. X are residing in U.S.A. Sister Angela is the sole companion of Mr. X and is looking after his needs and welfare. It has been 10 years and neither the daughter nor the sons have visited Mr. X or inquired about his wellbeing. On the contrary, Sister Angela has with great care and attention looked after the old man. Mr. X is the owner of number of flats situated at Delhi NCR. In addition, Mr. X has a saving bank account in Swiss Bank. It is the desire and intent of Mr. X that after his death his entire property, both movable and immovable needs to be bequeathed in favor of Sister Angela to the specific exclusion of the two sons and daughter.

Draft a will as per the wishes of Mr. X.

PROJECT No :: 09

Mr. X has been defamed and been disrespected by one Mr. Z in a political rally in Jamshedpur. Mr. X has been called a political opportunist and a highly immoral person. These defamatory statements were made in the presence of huge crowd and many of those believed. The person who has been defamed, Mr. X, wants to uphold his character and dignity. He contexts you so that appropriate civil proceedings could be initiated against Mr. Z. Draft a suit claiming appropriate damages in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendant.
