Mr. Lakshay Jindal is an alumnus of Lloyd Law College, Greater Noida. Having graduated in 2020, Mr. Jindal began his legal journey as an Advocate at the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh, where he has been handling an array of cases, ranging from writ petitions to criminal matters, demonstrating his versatile legal acumen. In his individual capacity, he has been dealing in criminal cases before the High Court and has been representing Tata Capital Housing Finance Ltd., ICICI Home Finance Co. Ltd., Jana Small Finance Bank, Umeed Housing Finance Pvt. Ltd., International Asset Reconstruction Company etc. in the Writ jurisdiction before the Hon'ble High Court and also handling other cases involving writ, inherent, revision, appellate and contempt jurisdiction of the High Court. To learn the practice of various other legal forums, Mr. Jindal also appears before the National Company Law Tribunal - Chandigarh Bench, Central Administrative Tribunal - Chandigarh Bench, State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, NRI Commission - Punjab, Customs Excise & Service Tax Appellate Tribunal, FCRs and Arbitral Tribunals constituted by the High Court etc.

During his time at law school, Mr. Jindal exhibited an unparalleled passion for translating legal theory into practical brilliance as he played an instrumental role in various pivotal student learning Cells, including the Lloyd-Trial Advocacy Cell and the Lloyd-Civil Practice Cell. His active participation not only honed his skills but also inspired his peers, fostering an environment of experiential learning and practical legal understanding. Besides doing continuous internships during his law school, he also published his four research papers. Mr. Jindal has also been commended with Letter of Appreciation by Law Commission of India for co-ordinating National Law Day 2017 which was organised in association with NITI Aayog and also been felicitated on many occasions for co-ordinating numerous events counting CLEA Regional Conference, Faculty Development Programme, and International Humanitarian Law Summer School, Catalyst 2020.

Mr. Jindal's commitment to giving back to the community is an integral facet of his journey. In 2017, he founded the NGO "Human Hands Together" and organised a National Symposium on "Law-not merely a Career" - a testament to his profound sense of social responsibility and during the Covid-19 pandemic, Online courses on Legal Drafting, Criminal Law Practice etc. were organised as he believe in leveraging legal knowledge for positive change.
