Legal Aid Movement in India

Article 39A of the Constitution of India provides that the State shall ensure that the operation of the legal system promotes justice on a basis of equal opportunity, and shall, provide free legal aid, by suitable legislation or schemes or in any other way, to ensure that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen because of economic or other disability.

The Lloyd Law College Legal Aid & Services Clinic is the body that inducts students to use their knowledge of the law to provide free legal aid to those most in need through various media. Its Legal Aid functions are preventive, remedial, activist, and reformative. We aim to spread legal awareness among students and people at large.

Achievements of Lloyd Legal Aid and Services Clinic

In the last five years, Lloyd Law College has undertaken several important initiatives, a few of them are:

- 1. Prison Release Assistance:** Helped release five inmates with legal and financial aid
- 2. Legal Awareness in Tihar Jail:** Provided legal awareness and assistance as Para Legal Volunteers (PLVs) to inmates in Tihar Jail No. 01 (for parole rights of convicted) and Jail No. 03 (for bail rights of undertrials) and offered legal awareness and assistance to inmates in different jails.
- 3. Special Criminal Law Training:** Provided awareness and training on issues like POCSO, DV, PNDD, and others to NGOs such as PRAYAS, GONJ, Society for Labour and Development (SLD), etc
- 4. Legal Aid Camps and Workshops:** Organized various legal aid camps and workshops.
- 5. Litigation Cell:** Established a Litigation Cell to provide special training to selected students in criminal trials as Para Legal Volunteers.

These initiatives demonstrate Lloyd Law College's commitment to legal aid, awareness, and social responsibility.

All the members will have a close engagement in the exercises done in the clinic. This involves drafting reports and conducting surveys for records. The students' members will be a part of multiple visits conducted in jails, NGOs, courts, and other organizations. These visits will offer them firsthand exposure to legal procedures and the functioning of the legal



system. This hands-on experience serves as a bridge, connecting the theoretical knowledge gained in the classroom with the practical realities of the legal field.
