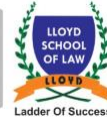
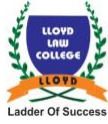

Eligibility Criteria ::

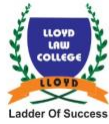
Rules of the JAM (Just a Minute) ::

1. **Time Limit** :: Each participant will have **exactly one minute** to speak on a given topic.
2. **Topic Allocation** :: Topics will be assigned randomly. Participants will have **30 seconds** to prepare.
3. **Speaking Criteria** :: The speaker must speak continuously for the allotted one minute. The speech should be relevant to the given topic.
4. **Language** :: The language of the speech must be either **English or Hindi**. Speakers **cannot switch** between the two languages during their speeches.
5. **No Repetition** :: Repetition of words, phrases, or ideas will lead to minus marking.
6. **Interruptions** :: No participant, judge or audience member is allowed to interrupt the speaker during their turn.

Judging Criteria ::

Participants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- **Content (10 Marks) :: How relevant and insightful is the content of the speech?**
- **Confidence and Command on Language (10 Marks) :: How confident and fluent is the speaker's delivery?**



- **Utilization of Time (10 Marks) :: How effectively does the speaker utilize the allotted time?**

Participants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with constitutional provisions, case laws, and contemporary debates for better performance.

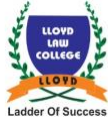
