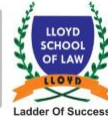
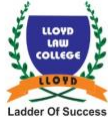

Happy Constitution Day!

Lloyd is celebrating the 75th Year of the Constitution of India as Samvidhan Week from Tuesday 26 - Saturday 30 Nov. 2024. We have planned various activities for the same. The details of activities, time and faculty in-charges are provided here. All are requested to take the charge of their respective duties. Faculty in-charge are requested to take students volunteers for working along with them in these activities.

Constitutional Law Quiz :: Rules and Guidelines

1. Eligibility Criteria

- Open to all undergraduate and postgraduate law students of the Lloyd.

2. Registration

- **Teams must do online registration latest before 07 AM, Wednesday 27 November, 2024.**

3. Format of the Quiz

The quiz will be conducted in two rounds:

a. Preliminary Round

- **Type ::** Written test (MCQs).
- **Duration ::** 25 minutes.
- **Time ::** 12:15 PM -to- 12:40 PM
- **Focus Areas ::** Basic concepts of the Indian Constitution, historical background, significant amendments, landmark judgments, and contemporary constitutional issues.

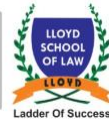
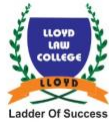
Note :: Top 15 participants will qualify for the next round.

b. Final Round

- **Type ::** Oral question-answer round in a buzzer format or rapid-fire round.
- **Duration ::** Approximately 1–1.5 hours.
- **Focus Areas ::** Constitutional Articles, Important doctrines, Case laws, Current constitutional debates and issues.

Note :: The team with the highest score wins.

4. Question Categories



Questions will cover:

- **Historical Background** :: Indian independence movement, Constituent Assembly Debates.
- **Core Constitutional Concepts** :: Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Federalism, Separation of Powers, etc.
- **Amendments & Provisions** :: Key constitutional amendments and their implications.
- **Judiciary** :: Landmark judgments, doctrines, and interpretation of Articles.
- **Contemporary Issues** :: Analysis of ongoing debates related to the Constitution.

5. Rules During the Quiz

- **Time Limit** :: Each team will have a set time (usually 15 sec) to answer a question.
- **Buzzer Use** :: Teams must press the buzzer only after the question is completely read. Incorrect answers on the buzzer will lead to negative marking.
- **Consultation** :: Teams can discuss among themselves but cannot consult any external sources (books, phones, etc.). Any such act will lead to immediate disqualification.
- **Tie-Breaker** :: In case of a tie, additional questions will be asked.

6. Scoring

- **Correct answers** :: +10 points (or as defined).
- **Incorrect answers** :: -5 points (optional negative marking).
- **Skipped questions** :: 0 points.

7. Conduct

- Teams must adhere to the instructions of the quizmaster.
- Participants must maintain decorum during the event.
- Any act of misconduct, cheating, or disruption will lead to disqualification.

8. Awards and Certificates

- **Winning Team** :: Cash prize of Rs 5000/- along with a certificate.
- **1st Runner-Up Team** :: Cash prize of Rs 3000/- along with a certificate.
- **2nd Runner-Up Team** :: Cash prize of Rs 2000/- along with a certificate.

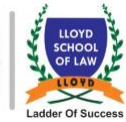
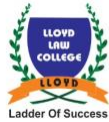
9. Judges/Quizmaster

Participants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with constitutional provisions, case laws, and contemporary debates for better performance.



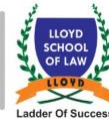
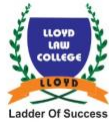
