IDENTITY CARD, CLASS TIME, UNIFORM & MANDATORY ATTENDANCE ::

Following points are of utmost importance and mandatory compliance by each and every student and parent for the uninterrupted functioning of academic process.

Identity Card ::

- There shall be **NO-ENTRY means NO-ENTRY** of anyone in the Lloyd Campus premises without Properly Wearing the Identity Cards. Anyone without wearing the ID Cards have to report to IT Office E-Garage for the same.

Class Time :: 08 am, 10 am, 12 Nn. ::

WE WILL CLOSE THE ENTRY GATE OF THE LAW SCHOOL / COLLEGE BOTH CAMPUSES PREMISES AT SHARP 08 AM, 10 AM, 12 Nn. DAILY.

- Each and every student must adhere by the class time on each occasion. Any ground for the delay in entering the class room will not be accepted. If you could not make it on time, kindly don't enter and disturb the ongoing academic process in the class. Late comers are directed to sit and read in the library / reading room area. Regular classes & Attendance :: 80% physical class attendance in all cases ::

- **80% physical class attendance in regular classes is the minimum criteria for appearing in the University Examination failing which the College will not approve the Odd Semester examination form of the students to the university.** This will cause into the extension of one full year and delay in completion of the law degree on the debarred student.
