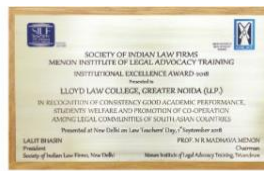

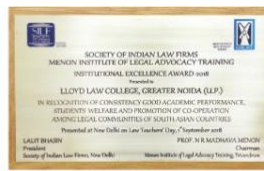

#### Debate in a Nutshell: The Key Elements

**DEBATE:** A process (a kind of sports) in which two opposing teams speak up to support their arguments and each one disagrees with those of the other team.

**RESOLUTION:** It's also called “Statement”. It is an issue about which the two teams argue. The issue to be debated is always controversial. It is usually worded with a solution to a problem. The debaters take two different “Positions” through which they debate the resolution; the “pro-position” is also called “affirmative side” and the “contra-position” is called the “opposite side”.

**ARGUMENT:** It is a controversial “Position” which consists of an “Assertion”, supported by “Reasoning” and “Evidence”.

**EVIDENCE:** It supports the “Reasoning” of an argument. Different types of Evidence are used in an argument. In general, evidence can be divided into two categories: “Facts” (data, statistic, studies and polls) and “Examples” (narratives and life experiences).

**COUNTER ARGUMENTS:** This term is also called “Rebuttal” or “Refutation”; it explains why one disagrees with the arguments of the other.



#### Do you know you debate every single day?

The last time you argued with your Parent/Guardian as to why you need to see a friend, not study for a while, watch a particular movie or simply apply for admission in a particular College/University because you don't want to leave your old friends behind; you argued.

**Is argumentation, a debate?** Is there a difference between “argumentation” and “debate”? Yes.

- Argumentation is reason giving to justify your acts, beliefs, attitudes, and values.
- Debate provides reasoned arguments for and against a proposition.



#### Why should you participate in this Debate?

- Because a good lawyer doesn't just argue. She argues **strongly!**



#### How do I debate, if I haven't participated earlier?

You just have to do the following:

- Speak with confidence and make sense.
- Prepare a list of your arguments.

→ Hear others' arguments and respond to them.



### What if, I do not participate?

You may miss on the **opportunity to know** how good you are at becoming a lawyer.

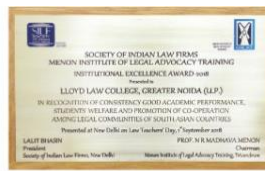

- There will be **no extra time** beyond 03 Minutes.
- Your video **must** be turned on with a **profile view**.
- **Dress formally & smartly.**
