### “How to write a judgment : Civil and Criminal?”

Judgment writing is a very important paper in mains examination of any Judicial services examination. It carries equal marks as other subjective papers and generally student find it difficult due to lack of real court experience. Questions set will be based on the principles of pleading. The questions to this will relate mainly to practical matters such as the framing of charges and issues, the methods of dealing with the evidence of witnesses and the writing of judgment. An aspirant must know the essentials of how to write a civil judgment and what to incorporate in criminal judgment. There are certain fundamental requirement of Evidence Law and Procedural law on the basis of which judgment is to be written.

This workshop will provide the students with the techniques of judgement writing as to issues framing, examination of witness, charge framing and finally the operative order part, how is this all to be written in the mains examination.
