Sumit Sen worked for the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) in Geneva and worldwide. He co-authored "The State of the World's Refugees". He has been widely published in books and international journals.

Mr. Sumit Sen has over 30 years of professional experience in Immigration and Refugee Law. He represents clients at the Federal Court of Canada, the Immigration and Refugee Board (IRB), at Immigration Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), at Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA).

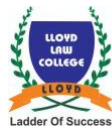
