Arbitration is emerging as the most effective and efficient method of Alternative Dispute Resolution. It helps parties to privately adjudicate their disputes by an impartial third party ("Arbitrator") without turning to court activities. Its distinctive difficulties start with the drafting of the Arbitration Agreement and proceed until the final award is enforced.

India is a booming economy with a young population and rising talents. It requires fundamental support and structural integrity of Legislative, Executive, Judiciary, and a conducive commercial mind-set, to create on-field conditions for strong effective, and time-bound dispute redressal process. GUIDELINE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF MOCK DISPUTE:

- The Mock Dispute shall consist of Short Details of Parties and their Disputing Relationship.
- The Mock Dispute shall address the Concerning matter and Applicable Laws of the arising conflict of interest.
- The Mock Dispute shall cover the need and interest of both the parties in a separate document.
- The Mock Dispute shall follow the General Format as like:
 - Font: Times New Roman
 - Font Size of body: 12
 - Font Size of Footnotes: 10
 - Spacing: 1.5
 - Margin – 1 inch on each side
 - Alignment of Body Text must be justified

LIAAP ELIMINATION ROUNDS:

- **CLIENT-COUNSELLING SESSION ::** Counseling a client is the significant function of a lawyer and the primary aim is to advise the people who seek assistance in knowing the legal implications of their actions. Through this, the students will be able to promote appropriate dispute resolution mechanisms.
- **MEDIATION & NEGOTIATION SESSION ::** Negotiation is a process in which both parties cooperate and seek a solution that is beneficial for both parties. Mediation is a process for resolving a dispute with the aid of an impartial and neutral third person who assists the parties in the dispute to reach a negotiated resolution.
- **ARBITRATION SESSION ::** Arbitration can be simply defined as a Private Adjudication Process in resolving Contractual or Non-Contractual claims by an independent and neutral third party called an arbitrator. Arbitration is a procedure in which a dispute is submitted to resolve under the terms of the disputing agreement



between the parties by one or more arbitrators (odd number) who make a binding decision on the dispute.

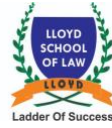
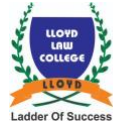
