He specializes in climate - law, finance, policy, energy policy, international trade & investment and geostrategy. He has experience across legal & policy consulting, legal practice, civil society & intergovernmental organizations, and academia on projects in India, the UK, Europe, Western Africa, and the Americas to provide intellectual rigor coupled with strategic thinking and practical solutions. In addition to his practice, he is a Climate Scholar and an Expert Reviewer of Reports for the United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC); the Advisor for India at the International Law Institute, Washington DC and the Indian Representative of the Youth Division at The Commonwealth Secretariat.

He is also the Co-Chair of the India - UK Legal Exchange Programme - an initiative by Indian and UK law firms in partnership with various other regulatory & government institutions including The Law Society of England & Wales and Members of House of Lords & House of Commons, UK Parliament. Manuj is currently serving as the Executive Secretary of The Indian National Association of Legal Professionals. In these roles, he combines his enthusiasm, technical knowledge, and deep networks to help a broad range of stakeholders take constructive action on climate change and the Sustainable Development Goals. Manuj enjoys a great professional relationships with various Heads of States and world leaders.

He is currently based in the US and pursuing his doctoral research at American University Washington College of Law where he focuses on current international climate policy and energy law topics [European Green Deal/CBAM] as well as topics that are at the forefront of public policy and debate [Climate Justice/Equity].
