Guidelines/instructions for preparing the Practical course File:

- **Scrutiny of Practical File** will be done **on the day of Practical Examination** first by our College Faculty and second by the External Examiner from the CCS University, Meerut.
- **MANDATORY PRESENCE** : Absence in any of the above Practical Course Work Exercise Examination will disentitle the student any marks, attendance, supplementary and fail thereof in all other theory and practical papers as per Examination Rules of the C.C.S. University, Meerut.
- **NO PLAGIARISM** : There should not be copying of the file, if found, both the files shall be rejected and marked 'ZERO'. The college shall not be responsible for the wrong doing of the student.
- **DRESS CODE** : Advocate Uniform is mandatory to appear for the 'Practical Paper' Viva-Voce exercise.
- **ADMIT CARD** : It is mandatory on every examinee to carry with their BA.LL.B Sem. VIII University Examination Admit Card as stamped by the college before the Examinations in Original for the Viva-Voce Examination.

TOPICS FOR PROJECT

NOTE :: WRITE ANSWER FOR ALL THE FOLLOWING PROJECT CASE/TOPICS.

PROJECT 01 ::

- Collect one plaint from any Civil Suit (from the office of Law Firm/ Advocate where you are engaged in internship or from any other source) and label it on the basis of:
 1. Orders, Rules and Appendix and other provisions of C.P.C., 1908 that govern the law of pleadings.
 2. Identify and label any three material facts in the plaint.

PROJECT 02 ::

- X took a loan of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) from his family friend, Y for a period of 2 years. After 1 year Y repaid a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only) to X but did not return the remaining loan amount even after a lapse of 2 years.
- Now X has approached you to file a Civil Suit.
- Using above premise, draft a plaint for X.
- **Note ::** Add your own appropriate facts other than given herein which are necessary to draft a plaint as per the law of pleading.

PROJECT 03 ::

- P and D are immediate neighbors. D has decided to reconstruct his old house and for that purpose D demolished his old house. Now without any approved plan, D has started digging his plot for constructing basement. This digging process has caused danger to the house of P which has started developing cracks and his house has also started leaning towards D's construction site. P objected to this construction and asked D to stop digging and making the basement. But D refused and continued to go for this construction.
- Aggrieved by the act of D, P has filed a civil suit against D.
- Using above premise, draft one stay application for P.

PROJECT 04 ::

- Draft one adjournment application for any of the party in a pending suit by using rules and all the parameters given in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.
- **Note ::** Add your own appropriate facts other than given herein which are necessary to draft a plaint as per the law of pleading.



PROJECT 05 ::

- A is caught red handed stealing a watch from a shop. The shopkeeper caught A and handed him over to police. Police arrested A, and a criminal case was registered against A. Now A is in jail.
- Using above premise, draft one bail application for A.

PROJECT 06 ::

- Draft one maintenance petition for a wife who is unable to maintain herself by using rules and all the parameters given in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
- **Note ::** Add your own appropriate facts other than given herein which are necessary to draft a plaint as per the law of pleading.

PROJECT 07 ::

- A is caught red handed stealing a watch from a shop. The shopkeeper caught A and handed him over to police. Police arrested A, and a criminal case was registered against A. After trial, court of magistrate convicted A vide judgment dated 25.01.2021.
- Using above premise, draft an appeal for A against above judgment.

PROJECT 08 ::

- Draft one civil appeal against original money decree passed by Senor Civil Judge by using rules and all the parameters given in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

PROJECT 09 ::

- Draft one written statement to the plaint drafted by you in Project No. 2.

PROJECT 10 ::

- A student secured admission in MBBS course in a medical college at UP. He was asked to submit one anti-ragging affidavit as per the UGC Regulation.
- Draft one anti-ragging affidavit for the student.
- **Note ::** Add your own appropriate facts other than given herein which are necessary to draft a plaint as per the law of pleading.
