She is an award-winning lawyer practicing at the Supreme Court, the Delhi High Court, District Courts, and various tribunals such as the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, National Company Law Tribunal and National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission. She specializes in dispute resolution including civil, criminal, and matrimonial matters.

Ms. Maini currently also serves as a Visiting Faculty for Criminal Laws, Human Rights, Supreme Court: Practice & Procedure, Women and Child Laws, Civil Procedure Code and International Crimes at various colleges such as National Law University, Delhi, Maharashtra National Law University Nagpur, Renaissance Institute of Law and Lloyd Law College, Noida.
