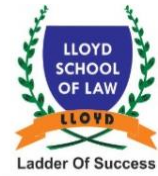

### WORKSHOP :: BASIC FUNDAMENTALS OF RESEARCH PAPER WRITING

#### Introduction

Legal professional shall always be a researcher; and researcher always remains a student because learning & understanding the research is a continuous process.

For a student of law, journey of learning & understanding the research begins with understanding its basic fundamentals at the law school. Within the curriculum, it is expected from the students that they would learn and understand the same concept/principle of law as explained by different authors or in different judgements. Beyond curriculum, it is expected that the student is participating in the moot competition or in seminar/conference that also require extensive research to succeed. This all shows the importance of learning the research for a student of law degree program.

We are delighted to inform you that the Lloyd Law College and the Lloyd Law School have taken the initiative to organize sessions on basic fundamentals of research for their students. There will be brief sessions with special emphasis on very basic fundamentals of the research that will help & guide the students in their journey of learning the research things at the law school.

#### Objectives

Participants will be able to identify a research problem and then to frame research questions. They will be able to identify the sources that will share the data/information required to complete their proposed research paper.
